

## Stakeholder Issues Prioritised

All participants at the Stakeholder Workshops were asked to indicate which issues they thought were most important within their Study Area. The figures below show the issues, the percentage of the responses they received and their overall rank out of all responses. Overall 'Gaps in Access' were top priority, followed by 'Nature Conservation Issues' and 'Natural Processes', however the priorities do vary between Study Areas.
