### Do I need to complete this form?

You should complete this form if you are planning work (i) to remove or add 4 km or more of field boundaries such as hedgebanks, walls, fences, ditches or tracks; and/or (ii) to move 10,000 m<sup>3</sup> of earth or rock; and/or (iii) to restructure an area of 100 ha or more.

An exception to these thresholds would be where any part of the project takes place in a *sensitive area* (e.g. National Park, the Broads, Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty or Scheduled Ancient Monument). In which case they are subject to lower thresholds of 2km, 5,000m<sup>3</sup> and 50ha respectively. Guidance on the Regulations is available. Please contact Natural England for advice (contact details above).

Please note that if you intend to conduct two or more sub-threshold projects, which will cumulatively exceed the thresholds, then this will be viewed as a single project that requires permission, even if the land manager conducts it gradually over a protracted time or if it involves different types of work.
