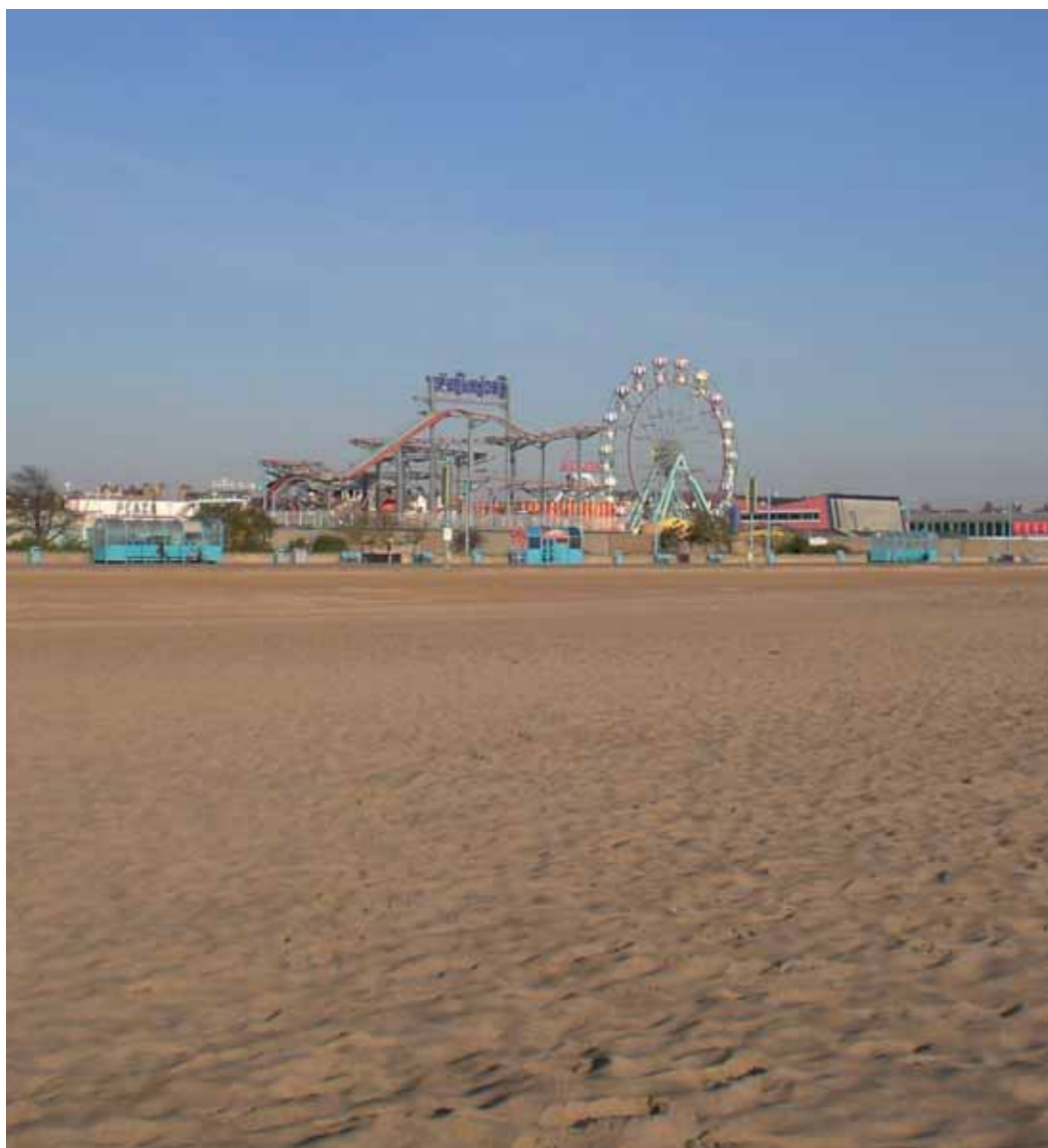


Flamborough Head to Gibraltar Point Shoreline Management Plan - Exhibitions
